#### **FGEHA BOARD UPDATES**

- Board meetings are scheduled for the 3rd Wednesday of the month from 7:00 pm 8:00 pm MST via Zoom. Agenda will be sent out via email a week before the meeting.

- There will be NO formal Fall Cleanup Day we will focus our efforts on a Spring Cleanup Day
- Since there will be no Fall Cleanup Day, we could still use some help with:
  - The walk-behind string trimmer alongside the roads
  - Sweeping off the recycle court
  - Removing dead trees in the hedge by the lagoon
- WAP (Wildfire Adapted Partnership needs a new volunteer coordinator. One meeting every two months plus
  working with neighbors on mitigation projects. Please put your volunteer hours in the pouch on the bulletin
  board.
- SPEED LIMIT: 10 m.p.h. This applies to EVERYONE. <u>Rental Owners and Short-Term Rental owners</u> are responsible for informing renters & their rental agents of this requirement and posting that information in the rental home.

#### **TRASH**

- NO Large items or furniture in dumpsters NO mattresses ever
- Free Area next to dumpsters has a <u>3 day limit</u>
  - Items need to then be removed by the person who left them there

## **RECYCLING**

Thanks for your help keeping recyclable materials out of the landfill.

- Allowable: plastic bottles, newspaper, magazines, old mail, and flattened cardboard boxes.
- **Prohibited:** styrofoam and plastic bags. If you collect your recyclables in a plastic bag please empty the bag and toss the plastic bag in the trash.

# WINTER IS COMING to Forrest Groves Estates -- a few reminders

- WINTERIZING YOUR HOME: Sometimes we have a cold snap and this might have an effect on your water and/or sewer system. In order to fix these problems in an efficient, timely manner, your water shut off value should be marked with a **blue** reflector and your sewer clean out marked with green reflector.
- CLOSING YOUR HOME FOR THE WINTER? Be sure to shut off your water valve and make sure a neighbor or Board member knows where your shutoffs are located ... just in case.
- COMMUNITY ROADS: Snow tends to cover everything. Every attempt will be made to make our roads safe and passable, but your help is needed.

- o Please place two *orange* reflector stakes by either side of your driveway. Email the Board if you need more information or support. Jen Redfern will have some available at the Fall Meet and Creet and will leave some at the mailboxes for a period of time.
- o Snow removal happens once we have 4 inches of snow. Generally, priority will be given to High Trails Drive from 521 High Trails to the entrance, then Verde Lane and Forrest Groves Lane
  - Let Tim Wheeler know if you would like to volunteer.
- o Community **speed limit** remains at **10 mph** during the winter months.
- o FGEHA has a 10-foot easement alongside roads. Check to make sure that you don't have anything in that easement such as decorations, large rocks, fences, tree branches that encroach, or other things that might damage snow removal equipment. FGEHA is **not** responsible for damage to anything in that easement.
- o Chains are advised up High Trails if the roads get icy.
- o Please do not throw or blow snow from your property onto the common roads, it just makes for inconvenience for our volunteer drivers.
- o POWER OUTAGES: Power outages can occur during the winter months and can last a while.
  - Our sewer system runs on power, so if power goes out, please limit flushing or it will cause our lift stations to back up.
  - Be sure to have some extra water on hand for consumption and toilets.
- FIREPLACE ASHES: Fireplace ashes need to be stored in a <u>metal</u> container and NOT placed on a wooden surface for at least a week before being placed in the dumpster. NO dumpster fires, please.
- SLEDDING: Please be cautious of sledders/skiers coming down High Trails. To keep everyone safe place the orange cones on the side of the road to alert drivers of your presence. This use is at your own risk.
